Hingemark Jig

Professional contractors and do-it-yourselfers can now install concealed European cabinet hinges in record time, thanks to the release of the new Canadian made **Hingemark** jig.

“**Hingemark** will ensure a perfect hinge alignment every time,” explains inventor Mark Coleiro.

“Just hold the jig against the edge of a cabinet or door, tap the spring-loaded pins with a hammer, and then attach the hinge with confidence. The days of time-consuming measurements are over!”

Field tests have shown that Hingemark can help users install cabinet hinges in one-third of the time when compared to traditional installation methods.
